2020 Commonwealth Tournament

JudoScotland

The Commonwealth Tournament will be held in Port Elizabeth, South Africa on the 21st – 26th September 2020

The event will likely see competition in 6 categories:

- Pre-Cadet
- Cadet
- Junior
- Senior
- Veteran
- Visually Impaired

This event will be a **SELF-FUND event for ALL JudoScotland judoka** meaning that participating judoka will be required to pay for their own entry, travel and accommodation.

JudoScotland will provide a delegation leader to oversee entry and accreditation processes.

PRE-CADET, VETERAN & VISUALLY IMPAIRED EVENTS

The entry for the *Pre-Cadet, Veteran & Visually Impaired* events is likely to be an *OPEN ENTRY* with no limit on entry numbers for each delegation.

Players wishing to participate in these categories would be expected to attend with their club. JudoScotland will fulfil any administrative tasks required for the NGB for these players but will not organise or oversee any logistics or coaching.

Club coaches should liaise with National Talent Development Coach, Gary Edwards, on their arrangements.

CADET, JUNIOR & SENIOR EVENTS

JudoScotland will limit entry for the **Cadet, Junior & Senior** events to **2 competitors per weight category**.

JudoScotland will implement a minimum requirement for participation in the cadet, junior and senior events.

The minimum requirement for the Cadet event will be that judoka feature (with points) on the GB Cadet Ranking List.

The minimum requirement for the Junior event will be that judoka feature with points on the GB Junior Ranking List.

The minimum requirement for the Senior event will be that judoka feature with points on the GB Senior Ranking List.

Should more than 2 players, meeting the minimum requirement in a category, apply to participate, the highest 2 players in the weight category on the appropriate GB Ranking List on 9th March 2020 will be given the places.

If multiple cadet players have identical points the player with highest ippon percentage is given priority.

If multiple junior players have identical points the player with the highest single result points is given priority.

If multiple senior players have identical points the player with the highest single result points is given priority.

TIMELINES

JudoScotland judoka looking to participate in the Cadet, Junior or Senior event should submit their request via email to commonwealth@judoscotland.com before 12 noon on Friday 28th February 2020.

You should title your email "Commonwealth Tournament – Entry Request" and include details of Player Name; Age Category & Weight Category you wish to enter.

JudoScotland will confirm the players who will participate on or before Friday 13th March 2020.

JudoScotland will book the trip before the end of April 2020. JudoScotland have costed the trip (Flight, B&B accommodation, Entry, Transfers) at approximately £1100 per person but will confirm trip cost in April 2020.
