2020 International JNR / SNR event support process



Dear Player / Coach

International JNR / SNR event support process in 2020

Please note that the following process for international event support will be initiated in 2020 for JNR & SNR events with the JudoScotland Performance Programme.

1. SIS supported judoka based at the JudoScotland National Training Centre (NTC) will have an individualised event programme, dependent on development need & competitive level.
2. Non-SIS supported judoka & SIS supported judoka based outwith the NTC, with a medal at JNR European Cup, SNR European Cup, SNR European Open (or a Top 7 at Grand Prix / Grand Slam) in 2019 will be given an opportunity to present their 2020 event plan & agree event support from the performance programme.
3. GB JNR Championship medallists will be offered the opportunity to attend JNR PORTUGAL & JNR SPAIN internationals.
Please Note that GB Championship medallists accepted onto the BJA Semi-Centralised EDS programme will be offered one (1) additional JNR International as GB will cover the cost for JNR PORTUGAL for these judoka.
4. GB SNR Championship medallists will be offered the opportunity to attend the Warsaw European Open & Swiss European Cup internationals.
5. Athletes gaining a Top 5 placing (with minimum of two (2) match wins) at any JudoScotland supported International event may be offered an additional international event in 2020.
6. The National High Performance Coach may, where they consider it to be in the best interests of JudoScotland, decide to offer additional competitive development opportunities.

Please note that judoka on the GB WCPP & judoka on the GB Centralised EDS programme will not receive any event support as their event programme is covered by BJA.

Offers of international event opportunities will be forwarded to the JudoScotland Performance Working Group for ratification.
