Seniors: Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> November 2021- Players must be 14 years or older on the day of competition (Senior will be split into two groups)
  - Senior 1<sup>st</sup> Kyu and above
  - Senior 2<sup>nd</sup> Kyu and below
7. Closing date: All entries and payment must be received by 1200 hours on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> October 2021.
8. JudoScotland reserve the right to close the entry prior to the published closing date if the maximum entry number has been reached.
9. Coaches Pass: All coaches must register through JudoScotland Members Zone. All requests must be received by 1200 hours on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> October 2021. (All coaches must have a valid coaching qualification)

## Entry Fee

10. Single entry fee. £25.00
11. Double entry fee(cadet & seniors) £40.00
12. Entry fees are non- refundable.

13. Telephone entries will be accepted if accompanied by a card payment.

16. Competition will commence at 10:00am.

## Rules & Method

17. All IJF contest rules will apply; all other rules will be in accordance with the latest BJA Tournament Handbook.
18. BJA restrictions will apply at all times.

## Eligibility

19. All players must have a current up-to-date membership of JudoScotland. It is the Judoka's responsibility to check that their licence is in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to compete.
20. All competitors must be within the specified age and weight limits for their category.
21. A competitor will be allowed to enter two sections if they are within the age limits specified.
  - A player may, if eligible, compete in both cadet and senior event.
22. Pre-cadets (B) born in the following years, **2008/2009**.
23. Cadets (C) born in the following years, **2005/2006/2007**.
24. Senior –Players must be 14 years or older on the day of competition. (Senior will be split into two groups)
  - Senior 1<sup>st</sup> Kyu and above
  - Senior 2<sup>nd</sup> Kyu and below
25. Contest times for Pre-Cadet: 3 Minutes,
26. Contest Times for Cadets and Seniors: 4 Minutes.

## Judogi

28. The wearing of **WHITE** judogi is compulsory for this event.
29. Competitors must have their own blue and white belts
30. The competitor called for a contest first must wear a white Belt
31. Competitors must wear suitable footwear and clothing at all times when off the mat.

## Registration & Weigh-in

32. Registration & weigh-in will take place on Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> November for **Pre-Cadet & Cadet**.
33. Registration & Weigh-in will take place on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> November for **Seniors**
34. Weigh-in times will be emailed to competitors and displayed on the JudoScotland website.
35. At registration players must show that their record book meets the minimum grade criteria.
36. Players must satisfy the minimum weight limit for their category, e.g. U34kg player must weigh a minimum of 30.7kg.
37. Players are able to change weight category, to a higher or lower category, at registration.
38. All weight categories will take place in an open weigh-in.
39. Pre- Cadet & Cadet players **MUST** weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers (and t-shirt for both female and male players) and will receive the appropriate weight allowances. (0.6kg)
40. Junior/Senior players **MUST** weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers (t-shirt for females) and will receive the appropriate weight allowances, female 0.9kg and Male 0.8kg.

41. Players are ONLY permitted to change in the designated official changing rooms.
42. The use of mobile phones is strictly not permitted within the changing rooms.

### **Weight Categories**

#### **43. Pre- Cadet (B) 2008/2009**

No Strangles or Arm Locks Permitted

- Female - U32kg, U36kg, U40kg, U44kg, U48kg, U52kg, U57kg, U63kg, Over 63kg
- Male - U30kg, U34kg, U38kg, U42kg, U46kg, U50kg, U55kg, U60kg, U66kg, Over 66kg

#### **44. Cadets (C) 2005/2006/2007**

Strangles and Arm Locks Permitted

- Female - U40kg, U44kg, U48kg, U52kg, U57kg, U63kg, U70, Over 70kg
- Male - U38kg, U42kg, U46kg, U50kg, U55kg, U60kg, U66kg, U73kg, U81kg, U90kg, Over 90kg

#### **45. Seniors will be split into two groups: (1<sup>st</sup> Kyu and above & 2<sup>nd</sup> Kyu and below)**

Strangles and Arm Locks Permitted

- Male – U50kg U55kg, U60kg, U66kg, U73kg, U81kg, U90kg, U100kg, Over 100kg

### **Medals**

47. 4 Medals will be awarded in each category where numbers permit. However competitors must have won at least one contest to be eligible for a medal.
48. The organisers reserve the right to combine age/weight categories when appropriate.
49. Medals will be presented throughout the day.

### **Mat side coaching**

50. Coaches must contact [info@judoscotland.com](mailto:info@judoscotland.com) prior to the closing date 1200 hours Monday 25th October 2021 to register for mat-side access.
51. Coaches must produce a valid BJA Coach Award card – in person- in order to be eligible to gain mat-side access with their player.
52. It is the coaches' responsibility to check that their credentials are in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to coach.

53. Chairs for two coaches per contest area, blue and white side will be provided. Only one coach allowed to this chair per competitor.
54. Coaches must adhere to the code of conduct for coaches which a copy will be provided at registration.

### **Spectator Ticketing**

55. Spectator tickets are available from 8.15 am at the JudoScotland welcome desk at the event venue.
56. A spectator ticket provides access as a spectator and does NOT permit you mat-side access.
