9. JudoScotland reserve the right to close the entry prior to the published closing date if the maximum entry number has been reached.
10. Coaches pass: All JudoScotland coaches can register online-www.judoscotland.com by 1200 hours Friday 21st October 2022.
11. Event T-shirt orders must be received by 1200 hours on Friday 21st October 2022.

Entry Fee

12. Single entry fee. £25.00 - Entry fees are non- refundable.
13. Double entry fee (cadet & seniors only) £40.00 - Entry fees are non- refundable.
14. Event T-shirt. Children sizes 7/8, 9/11, 12/13, 14/15 £10.00.
15. Event T-shirt. Adult sizes Small, Medium, Large, XL, 2XL, 3XL
16. Event T-shirt fees are non- refundable (collection from JudoScotland reception on the day of event)

18. Telephone entries will be accepted if accompanied by a card payment.

Event Type

19. Level 3 Point Scoring

Level three events are designed for players who have had substantial experience at level two events.

Competition Start

20. Competitors must arrive at their designated weigh-in times.
21. Competition will commence at 10:00am.

Rules & Method

22. All IJF contest rules will apply; all other rules will be in accordance with the latest BJA Tournament Handbook.
23. BJA restrictions will apply at all times.

Eligibility

24. All players must have a current up-to-date membership of JudoScotland. It is the Judoka's responsibility to check that their licence is in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to compete.
25. All competitors must be within the specified age and weight limits for their category.
26. A competitor will be allowed to enter two sections if they are within the age limits specified.
 - A player may, if eligible, compete in both cadet and senior event only.
27. Minors (A) Band born in the following years, **2011/2012**
28. Pre-cadets (B) Band born in the following years, **2009/2010**.
29. Cadets (C) Band born in the following years, **2006/2007/2008**.
30. Senior –Players must be 14 years or older on the day of competition. (Senior will be split into two groups)
 - Senior 1st Kyu and above
 - Senior 2nd Kyu and below
31. Contest times Minors (A) Band: 3 Minutes.
32. Contest times for Pre-Cadet (B) Band: 3 Minutes.
33. Contest Times for Cadets (C) Band 4 Minutes.
34. Contest Times for Seniors: 4 Minutes.
35. This is a level 3-point scoring event, please can coaches make sure that your club players only enter if they are the appropriate level. See point 19.

Judogi

37. The wearing of **WHITE** judogi is compulsory for this event.
38. Competitors must have their own blue and white belts
39. Competitors must wear suitable footwear and clothing at all times when off the mat.

Registration & Weigh-in

40. Registration & weigh-in will take place on Saturday 5th November for **Pre-Cadet (B) Band & Cadet (C) Band**.
41. Registration & Weigh-in will take place on Sunday 6th November for **Minors (A) Band & Seniors**
42. If a player is entering into Cadet and Seniors, their weight will be carried forward to the following day, but they must still attend registration at the appropriate time.
43. Weigh-in times will be emailed to competitors and displayed on the JudoScotland website.
44. At registration players must show their valid JudoScotland record book.

45. Players must satisfy the minimum weight limit for their category, e.g., U34 kg player must weigh a minimum of 30.7 kg.
46. Players can change weight category, to a higher or lower category, at registration.
47. All weight categories will take place in an open weigh-in.
48. Minors (A) Band, Pre-Cadet (B) Band & Cadets (C) Band **MUST** weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers (and t-shirt for both female and male players) and will receive the appropriate weight allowances. (0.6kg)
49. Senior players **MUST** weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers (t-shirt for females) and will receive the appropriate weight allowances, female 0.9kg and Male 0.8kg.
50. Players are ONLY permitted to change in the designated official changing rooms.
51. The use of mobile phones is strictly not permitted within the changing rooms.

No Strangles or Arm Locks Permitted

- Male - U34kg, U38kg, U42kg, U46kg, U50kg, U55kg, U60kg, U66kg, +66kg

55. Seniors will be split into two groups: (1st Kyu and above & 2nd Kyu and below)

- Male – U55kg, U60kg, U66kg, U73kg, U81kg, U90kg, U100kg, +100kg

Medals

57. 4 Medals will be awarded in each category where numbers permit. However, competitors must have won at least one contest to be eligible for a medal.

58. The organisers reserve the right to combine age/weight categories when appropriate.

59. Medals will be presented throughout the day, except for senior categories where finals will be held at the end of the day.

Mat side coaching

60. Coaches must register for a coaching pass online www.judoscotland.com prior to the closing date 1200 hours Friday 21st October 2022 to register for mat-side access.

61. It is the coaches' responsibility to check that their credentials are in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to coach.

62. Chairs for two coaches per contest area, blue and white side will be provided. Only one coach allowed to this chair per competitor.

63. Coaches must adhere to the code of conduct for coaches which a copy will be provided at registration.

64. Coaches, please ensure that you attend the coaches briefing prior to the commencement of the event. The referee in charge will give a briefing on any updates.
