

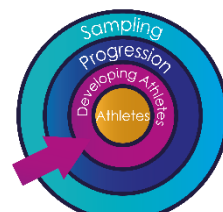
The Scottish National Closed Championship 2023

8. Closing date: All entries and payment must be received by 1200 hours on Wednesday 1st November 2023.
9. JudoScotland reserve the right to close the entry prior to the published closing date if the maximum entry number has been reached.
10. Event T-shirt orders must be received by 1200 hours on Wednesday 1st November 2023.

Entry Fee

11. Single entry fee. £30.00 - Entry fees are non- refundable.
12. Double entry fee (Cadet & Juniors) (Junior & Senior) £55.00 - Entry fees are non- refundable.
13. Triple entry fee (Cadet, Junior & Senior) £80.00
14. Event T-shirt. Children sizes: 7/8, 9/11, 12/13, 14/15 £12.00.
15. Event T-shirt. Adult sizes: Small, Medium, Large, XL, 2XL, 3XL £14.00. Event T-shirt fees are non- refundable (collection from JudoScotland reception on the day of event)

Entry/Payment

16. JudoScotland members can enter online – www.judoscotland.com.
17. Telephone entries will be accepted if accompanied by a card payment.

Event Type

18. Level 3 Point Scoring - This is a level 3 Point scoring event; please can coaches make sure that your club players only enter if they are the appropriate level. Level 3 events are designed for players who have had substantial experience at level two events.

Rules & Method

19. All IJF/BJA contest rules will apply; all other rules will be in accordance with the latest BJA Tournament Handbook.

Eligibility

20. All players must have a current up-to-date membership of JudoScotland. It is the Judoka's responsibility to check that their licence is in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to compete.
21. Judoka and Coaches to ensure player's correct grade is recorded in their record book.
22. All competitors must be within the specified age and weight limits for their category.
23. A competitor will be allowed to enter two sections if they are within the age limits specified.
 - A player may, if eligible to compete in both cadet and senior event. Please check with your coach if this is an option for you.
24. Minors (A) Band born in the following years, **2012/2013**. Contest times Minors (A) Band:
 - a. BJA technical restrictions will apply for Minors, contest time 3 minutes, 3 minutes Golden Score, Referee Decision.
25. Pre-cadets (B) Band born in the following years, **2010/2011**. Contest times for Pre-Cadet (B) Band: 3 minutes.
26. Cadets (C) Band born in the following years, **2007/2008/2009**. Contest times for Cadets (C) Band 4 minutes.
27. Juniors (JRN) born in the following years, **2004/2005/2006/2007/2008/2009**. Contest times Juniors (JRN) 4 minutes
28. Senior players must be 14 years or older on the day of competition. (Seniors will be split into two groups)
 - Senior 1st Kyu and above
 - Senior 2nd Kyu and below
 - Contest Times for Seniors: 4 Minutes.
29. If you are uncertain of your eligibility, please contact JudoScotland on 0131 333 2981

Judogi

30. The wearing of **WHITE** judogi is compulsory for this event.
31. Competitors must have their own blue and white belts.
32. Competitors must always wear suitable footwear and clothing when off the mat.

Registration & Weigh-in

33. Registration & weigh-in will take place on Saturday 11th November 2023 at competition venue.
34. If a player is entering into Cadet and Juniors, Junior and Senior or Cadet, Junior & Senior they will only need to weigh in once.
35. Weigh-in times will be emailed to competitors and displayed on the JudoScotland website.
36. At registration players must show their valid JudoScotland license and record book.
37. Players must satisfy the minimum weight limit for their category,
 - a. e.g., U34 kg player must weigh a minimum of 30.7 kg.
38. Players can change weight category, to a higher or lower category, at registration.
39. Players are **ONLY** permitted to change in the designated official changing rooms.
40. The use of mobile phones is not permitted within the changing rooms.

41. Weigh in allowance.

- a. All genders of all ages in all British events are entitled to wear a T-shirt/Rash Guard at both weigh in and during the contest should they wish to do so.

Female	Must wear a T-shirt/Rash Guard, with competition legal judogi trousers	0.8kg	Must wear a T-shirt/Rash Guard with their judogi
Male U18	Must wear a T-shirt/Rash Guard, with competition legal judogi trousers	0.8kg	Can choose to wear a T-shirt/Rash Guard with their judogi
Male 18 and over	Can choose to wear a T-shirt/Rash Guard, but must wear competition legal judogi trousers	0.7kg for trousers only +0.1kg if a T-shirt /Rash Guard is worn	Can choose to wear a T-shirt/Rash Guard with their judogi

42. Minors (A) Band-Year born 2012/2013

No Strangles or Arm Locks Permitted

- Female -U28kg, U32kg, U36kg, U40kg, U44kg, U48kg, U52kg, U57kg, U63kg, +63kg
- Male -U27kg, U30kg, U34kg, U38kg, U42kg, U46kg, U50kg, U55kg, U60kg, U66kg, +66kg

If the player is in the Over category, please state their exact weight in Kg.

43. Pre- Cadet (B) Band Year born 2010/2011

No Strangles or Arm Locks Permitted

- Female - U32kg, U36kg, U40kg, U44kg, U48kg, U52kg, U57kg, U63kg, +63kg
- Male - U34kg, U38kg, U42kg, U46kg, U50kg, U55kg, U60kg, U66kg, +66kg

If the player is in the Over category, please state their exact weight in Kg.

44. Cadets (C) Band-Year born 2007/2008/2009.

Strangles and Arm Locks Permitted

- Female - U40kg, U44kg, U48kg, U52kg, U57kg, U63kg, U70kg, +70kg
- Male - U42kg, U46kg, U50kg, U55kg, U60kg, U66kg, U73kg, U81kg, U90kg, +90kg

If the player is in the Over category, please state their exact weight in Kg.

45. Juniors (JRN) Year born 2004/2005/2006/2007/2008/2009

Strangles and Arm Locks Permitted

- Female - U44kg, U48kg, U52kg, U57kg, U63kg, U70kg, -78kg, +78kg
- Male - U55kg, U60kg, U66kg, U73kg, U81kg, U90kg, -100kg, +100kg

If the player is in the Over category, please state their exact weight in Kg.

46. Seniors will be split into two groups: (1st Kyu and above & 2nd Kyu and below)

Strangles and Arm Locks Permitted

- Female - U48kg, U52kg, U57kg, U63kg, U70kg, U78kg, +78kg
- Male – U60kg, U66kg, U73kg, U81kg, U90kg, U100kg, +100kg

If the player is in the Over category, please state their exact weight in Kg.

Medals

47. 4 Medals will be awarded in each category where numbers permit. However, competitors must have won at least one contest to be eligible for a medal.

48. The organisers reserve the right to combine age/weight categories when appropriate.

49. Medals will be presented throughout the day, except for senior categories where finals will be held.
