Rules:	<u>**British Judo Association Technical Restrictions will apply.**</u> Would all coaches / parents please provide <u>all information</u> requested on the online entry. All players will be put into pools of 4 or 5 plus or minus 3kg, matched by belt colour and where possible, age.
Weigh In:	A draft timetable will be emailed after the closing date. The competition controller reserves the right to merge categories when and as required. * All players will be weighed on the day. In line with BJA policy all players must wear a t shirt during weigh in*
